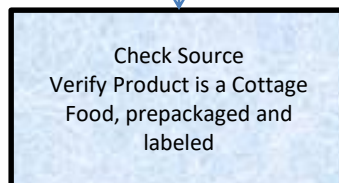
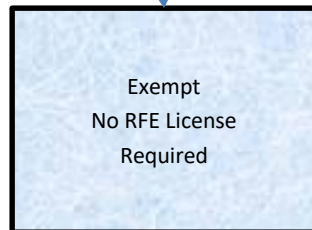


Vendors at Farmers' Markets

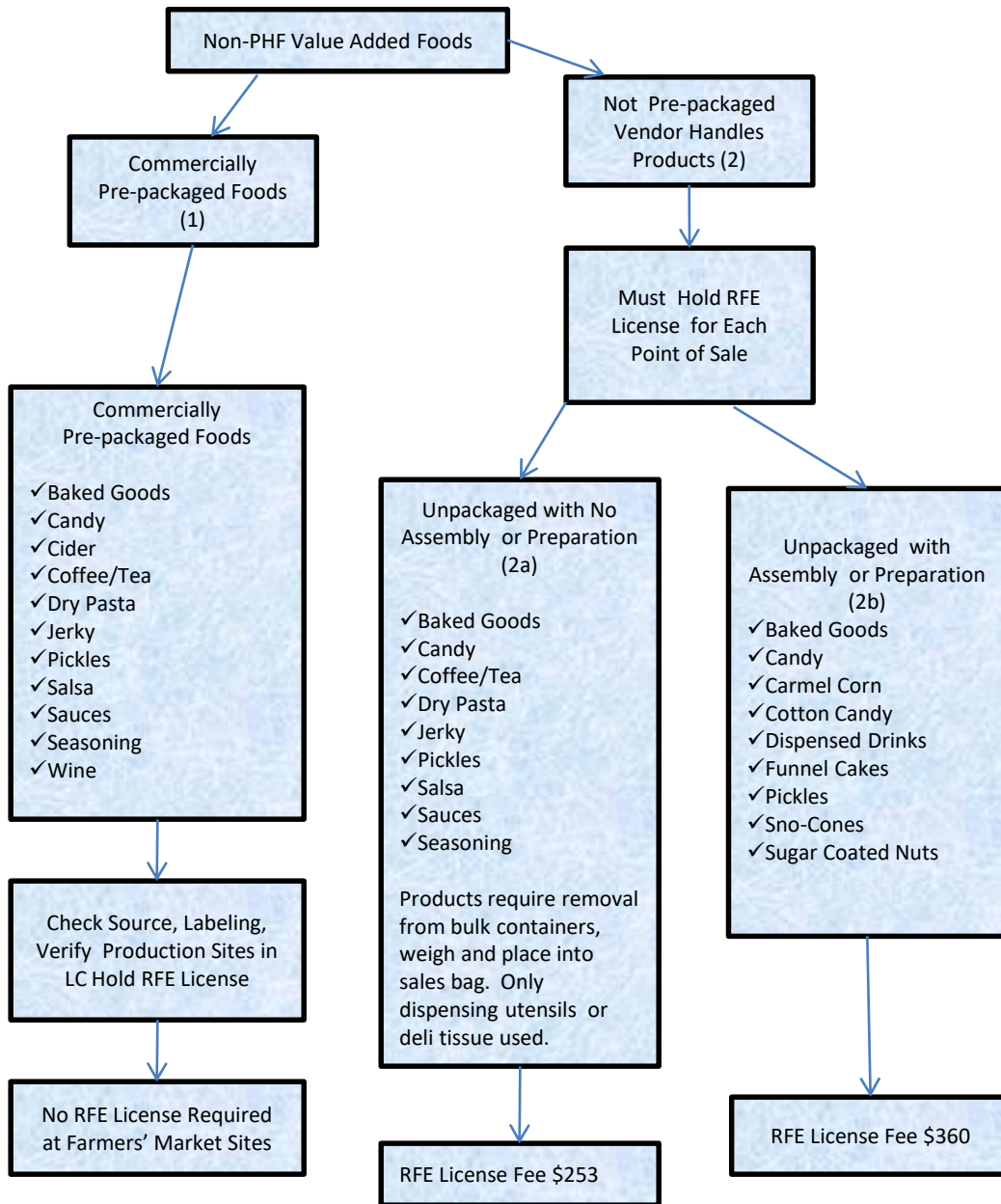
Produce / Cottage Foods



- CRS 25-4-1602(14)(j) allows for the sale of whole and uncut fruits and vegetables without RFE license.
- CRS 25-4-1614 allow for the sale of cottage foods without a RFE license.
- Minimal processing of produce such as rinsing off dirt and gross debris, and trimming dead leaves is allowed.
- Mixed and Micro greens refer to fresh leafy greens and spices subject only to minimal post harvest processing. The product is offered to the consumer in its raw form and is intended to be washed by the consumer prior to consumption.
- Honey combs are considered a raw agricultural commodity.
- Samples are allowed to be provided to the public.
- RFE License is required for the sale of cut melons, ready-to-eat salad mixes, roasted peppers and other value added agricultural products.
- Cottage foods are limited to raw shell eggs, pickled fruits and vegetables, spices, teas, dehydrated produce, nuts, seeds, honey, jams, jellies, preserves, fruit butter, flour, and baked goods, including candies, fruit empanadas, and tortillas, and other non-potentially hazardous foods.
 - ✓ Must be individually prepackaged and sold packaged.
 - ✓ Must be labeled with:
 - Producer's name
 - Address where food was prepared,
 - Producer's telephone number or email,
 - Date when the food was produced
 - Complete list of ingredients
 - Disclaimer: "This product was produced in a home kitchen that is not subject to state licensure or inspection and that may also process common food allergens such as tree nuts, peanuts, eggs, soy, wheat, milk, fish, and crustacean shellfish. This product is not intended for resale."

Vendors at Farmers' Markets

Non PHF Foods



Operations that prepare, repack, or assemble and sell foods directly to the public must hold a RFE License. The type of RFE License and the license fee is dependent upon the type of food that is made and sold, if the food is to be sold packaged or unpackaged, and if the food is intended to be consumed on or off the premises where it is sold.

Samples, hot coffee and hot tea are allowed to be provided to the public at booths operating at Farmers' Markets without a RFE License.

Pre-Packaged Food (1)

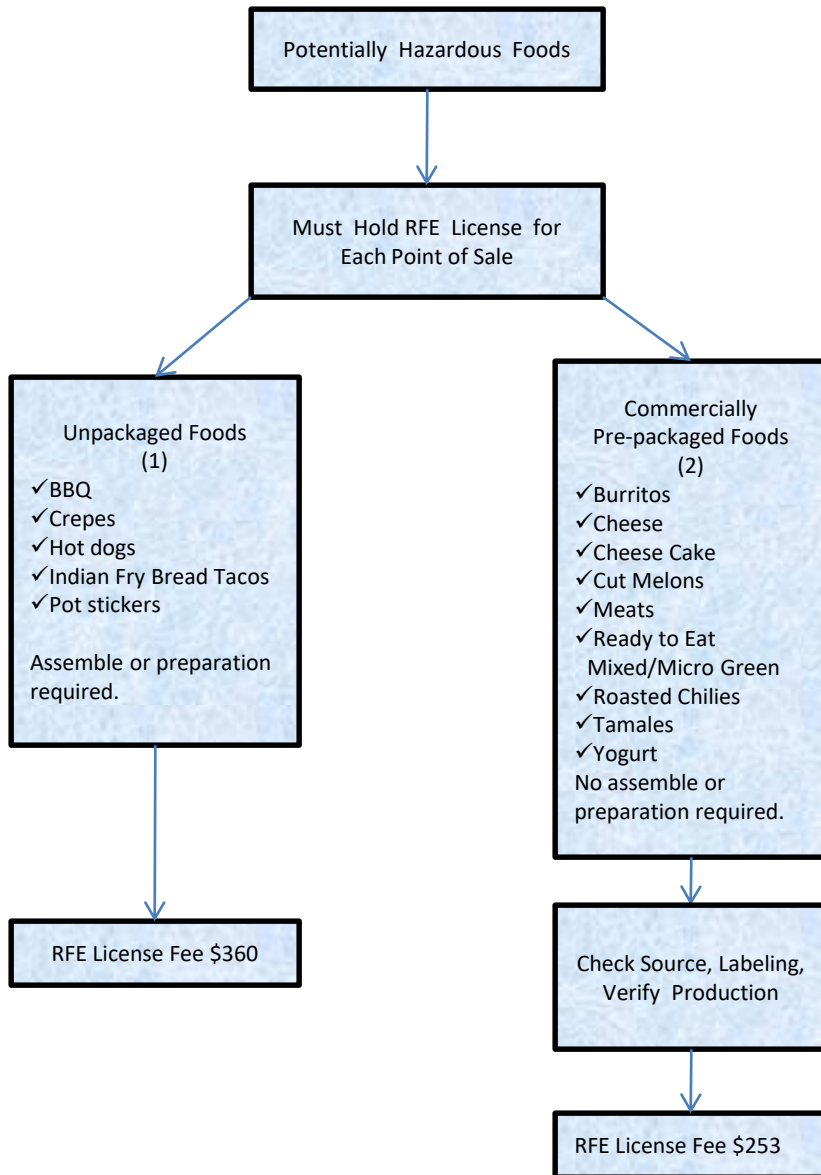
- Cottage foods vendors are not required to obtain a RFE License. Food must be sold pre-packaged and must be properly labeled.
- The location where the food products are made and packaged is required to hold a RFE License. The booth at the Farmers' Market is not required to hold a RFE License.
- Bottled wine, beer and products that are co-packed at an approved manufacturing firm for an operator are not required to hold a RFE License.
- RFE Licensing for the production site will vary depending upon the type of establishment.
 - ✓ Restaurant or Specialty Shop with retail sales at the production site: RFE License=\$253/\$360, Liability Codes=2000/3000, Establishment Type =Specialty Shops, Full Service, Fast Food, Deli.
 - ✓ GMP type manufacturing facility: no RFE License required

Un-Packaged (2)

- The location where the products are made is required to hold a RFE License (see commissary exception 2b). The booth at the Farmers' Market also must hold a RFE License.
- RFE Licensing for the production site will be the same as for Pre-Packaged Food (1) above.
- Booths for vendors serving Unpackaged Non-PHF Foods requiring No Assembly or Preparation (2a) at the Farmers' Market site needs to hold a RFE License =\$253, Liability Code=2000, Establishment Type=Retail Specialty Shop and must have:
 - ✓ Hand washing station, hot & cold water, hand soap and dispensed hand towels.
 - ✓ Food must be store protected, off ground, covered, not accessible to contamination by the public.
 - ✓ Dispensing utensils to prevent bare hand contact.
- Vendors serving Unpackaged Non-PHF Foods for Immediate Consumption (2b) at Farmers' Market sites must operate from a fully equipped push cart/mobile unit that holds a RFE License. The commissary the push cart/mobile unit is based out of is not required to hold a RFE License unless retail food sales take place at the commissary location. Push carts/mobile units will be RFE License =\$360, Liability Code=6300, Establishment Type =Mobile Unit

Vendors at Farmers' Markets

PHF Foods



Vendors serving PHF Foods at Farmers' Market sites are considered to be a push cart/mobile unit and must hold a RFE License. The commissary the push cart/mobile unit is based out of is not required to hold a RFE unless retail food sales take place at the commissary location.

Samples are allowed to be provided to the public.

Unpackaged PHF Foods (1)

- Vendors serving Unpackaged PHF Foods at Farmers' Market sites must operate from a fully equipped push cart/mobile unit that holds a RFE License. The commissary the push cart/mobile unit is based out of is not required to hold a RFE License unless retail food sales take place at the commissary location. Push carts/mobile units will be RFE License = \$360, Liability Code = 6300, Establishment Type = Mobile Unit.

Commercially Pre-packaged PHF Foods (2)

- Vendors serving Pre-packaged PHF Foods at Farmers' Market sites are considered mobile units limited to service of pre-packaged foods only. These mobile units will be RFE License = \$253, Liability Code = 6200, Establishment Type = Retail Mobile Unit and must have:
 - ✓ Easily cleanable equipment that can maintain PHF foods at <41°F or >135°F. Hard plastic coolers are allowed provided they hold food at proper temperatures.
 - ✓ Thermometer to monitor holding equipment temperatures.
 - ✓ Products must have full labels: product name, name of manufacture, address/phone number of manufacture, list of ingredients, and net weight.
- Eggs can be offered for sale loose, or in cartons. Eggs can be sold without a RFE License as a Cottage Food.
- Chili roasting operations where whole chilies are cooked in a large roaster, placed in to a bag and sold directly to customers. No RFE License is required if the chilies are roasted as a service after the sale. A RFE License is required if chili's are roasted and held prior to sale. RFE License = \$253, Liability Code = 2000, Establishment Type = Retail Specialty Shop.
